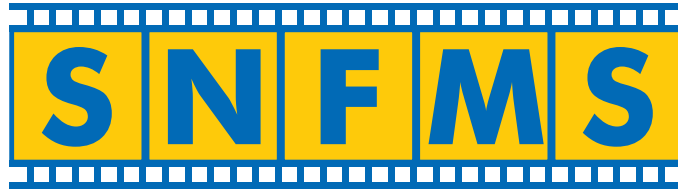

- May 19 **Grease** (1978)
This all-time-favorite musical stars John Travolta, Olivia Newton-John, and Stockard Channing. Good girl Sandy and greaser Danny fell in love over the summer. But when they unexpectedly discover they're now in the same high school, will they be able to rekindle their romance?
- May 26 **Some Like It Hot** -- Black and White (1959)
Genre: Comedy/Crime Starring: Marilyn Monroe, Tony Curtis and Jack Lemmon. Directed by Billy Wilder. When two musicians witness a mob hit, they flee the state in an all female band disguised as women, but further complications set in.
- June 9 **In and Out** (1997)
This eye-opening comedy stars Kevin Klein, Joan Cusack, Tom Selleck, Matt Dillon, and Debbie Reynolds. Directed by Frank Oz. A Midwestern teacher questions his sexuality after a former student makes a comment about him at the Academy Awards.
- June 16 **Star Trek 2: The Wrath of Khan** (1982)
Genre: Adventure/Sci-Fi; Directed by: Nicholas Meyer; Starring: William Shatner, Leonard Nimoy, DeForest Kelley, and James Doohan. Admiral Kirk's midlife crisis is interrupted by the return of an old enemy looking for revenge and a potentially destructive device.
- June 23 **CLUE** (1985)
Genre: Comedy/Crime/Mystery; Starring: Tim Curry, Madeline Kahn, Christopher Lloyd, Michael McKean, Martin Mull, Eileen Brennan, and Lesley Ann Warren. Six guests are invited to a strange house and must cooperate with the staff to solve a murder mystery. It's not just a game anymore!
- July 7 **Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire** (2005)
Genre: Adventure/Family/Fantasy/Mystery; Directed by: Mike Newell. Based on the fourth installment of the popular books by J.K. Rowling. Starring: Daniel Radcliffe, Emma Watson and Rupert Grint. Harry finds himself selected as an underage competitor in a dangerous multi-wizardary school competition.

The Straight Story (1999)

Genre: Adventure/Biography/Drama; Starring: Richard Farnsworth, Sissy Spacek, Harry Dean Stanton; Directed by David Lynch. "The Straight Story" chronicles a trip made by 73-year-old Alvin Straight from Laurens, IA, to Mt. Zion, WI, in 1994 while riding a lawn mower. The man undertook his strange journey to mend his relationship with his ill, estranged, 75-year-old brother Lyle.

- July 21 **The Santa Clause** (1994)
Genre: Kids and Family/Christmas; Starring: Tim Allen, Wendy Crewson, and Judge Reinhold. When a man inadvertently kills Santa on Christmas Eve, he finds himself magically recruited to take his place.
- July 28 **Seven Brides for Seven Brothers** (1954)
Genre: Comedy/Musical; Starring: Howard Keel, Jane Powell, Jeff Richards and Russ Tamblyn. Adam, the eldest of seven brothers, goes to town to get a wife. He convinces Milly to marry him that same day. Only then does she discover he has six brothers -- all living in his cabin. Milly sets out to reform the uncouth siblings, who are anxious to get wives of their own. Then, after reading about the Roman capture of the Sabine women, Adam develops an inspired solution to his brothers' loneliness . . . kidnap the women they want!
- August 4 **Dear Window** (1954)
Genre: Mystery/Thriller; Directed by Alfred Hitchcock; Starring: Jimmy Stewart and Grace Kelly. A wheelchair bound photographer spies on his neighbors from his apartment window and becomes convinced one of them has committed murder. This film was nominated for four Oscars!
- August 11 **Landlocked Film Festival**
- August 18 **Spirited Away** (2002)
Genre: Japanese Animation/Adventure/Family; Directed by: Hayao Miyazaki and Kirk Wise (co-directed the English version). In 2003, this film won an Oscar for *Best Animated Feature*. In the middle of her family's move to the suburbs, a sullen 10 year-old girl wanders into a world ruled by gods, witches, and monsters; where humans are changed into animals.
- August 25 **Step Up** (2006)
Genre: Drama/Music/Dance/Romance; Starring: Channing Tatum, Jenna Dewan and Damaine Radcliff. Everyone deserves a chance to follow their dreams, but some people only get one shot. Every second chance begins with a first step.
- September 1 **The Maltese Falcon** - Black and White (1941)
Genre: Film-Noir/Mystery; Directed by John Huston. Featuring an all-star cast: Humphrey Bogart, Mary Astor and Peter Lorre. Sam Spade is a partner in a private-eye firm who finds himself hounded by police when his partner is killed whilst tailing a man. The girl who asked him to follow the man turns out not to be who she says she is, and is really involved in something to do with the 'Maltese Falcon', a one-of-a-kind gold-encrusted life-sized statue of a falcon.

- September 15 **Back to the Future** (1985)
Genre: Action/Adventure/ Comedy; Directed by Robert Zemeckis; Starring: Michael J. Fox, Christopher Lloyd and Leah Thompson. In 1985, Doc Brown invented time travel, in 1955, Marty McFly accidentally prevented his parents from meeting, putting his own existence at stake.
